### **SUMMARY**

#### Synopsis of Bill

House Joint Memorial 20 would request that the Department of Public Safety convene a task force and study the feasibility of designing, constructing, operating and funding a facility for training law enforcement and correctional officers for tactical response teams. The task force would consist of members from the law enforcement and community organizations, including mental health professionals and advocates for the homeless and others living in poverty.

The task force would identify methods to create courses, including courses on standardized use of firearms and qualifications for tactical responses. The task force would also identify methods to standardize the evaluation process for officers on tactical response teams and their instructors.

Additionally, the task force would identify service providers outside the law enforcement community who may provide education on mental health, homelessness, poverty, community policing, and other issues. The task force would also identify methods to standardize collection of post-incident information and other data to improve future tactical responses.

# FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

DPS stated that there would be no fiscal impact but that there would be a minimal administrative impact.
