SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 164 appropriates \$12 million from the general fund to the development training fund for expenditure in fiscal year 2016 and subsequent fiscal years for the Job Training Incentive Program (JTIP), administered by the Economic Development Department (EDD).

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$12 million contained in this bill is a nonrecurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of a fiscal year shall not revert to the general fund.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

JTIP provides funds for classroom and in-plant training for new employees, existing employees moving to higher-skill positions (the Step-Up program), and interns. Funding primarily goes directly to businesses to offset a portion of new employees' wages during their on-the-job

training period. See "Appendix A" for a list of FY14 JTIP expenditures.

EDD supplied the following information in its analysis.

A historical review of JTIP shows that on average JTIP has expended \$4.7 million per year. Going back to 2000, JTIP's expenditures reflect the following:

- Average projects funded per year: 46
- Average obligation per project: \$213 thousand
- Average investment per trainee: \$5,500
- Average expenditure (actual draw-downs) per year: \$4.8 million

PERFORMANCE IMPLICATIONS

EDD notes that if the agency meets its goal of creating 1,000 jobs through JTIP in FY15 and the average investment per JTIP trainee is \$5,500, the program would require \$5.5 million to meet the minimum job creation needs. As of mid-year FY15 (December), JTIP has met just over 50 percent of its job creation goal by funding 510 jobs.

ADMINISTRATIVE IMPLICATIONS

There would be no additional administrative duties. EDD administers JTIP funds and the Industrial Training Board is responsible for establishing policy, promulgating rules, and making expenditure decisions.

DUPLICATION, RELATIONSHIP

The bill duplicates HB 309. The appropriation also relates to and partially duplicates appropriations in HB 2, which contains \$7.5 million for JTIP -- \$2 million in the recurring base budget and \$5.5 million in a nonrecurring special appropriation.
