SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

Amends Section 13-1-22 NMSA 1978 to allow verification of veteran status by proof that "the veteran died while in the service of the armed forces of the United States, and that the business is owned by (a) a veteran or veterans; (b) a parent or surviving spouse of a veteran; or (c) parents or surviving spouses of veterans.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

TRD stated that the Audit and Compliance Division of TRD will need to revise forms, publications and web site pages to reflect the changes. Audit procedures will need to be developed for approving applications.

GSD stated that there should be no fiscal impact to the State Purchasing Division (SPD), as the preference is determined by TRD and applied to procurements by SPD and other public entities when bidders or offerors attach proof of their preference entitlement to their bids or offers.
