Synopsis of Bill

Senate Joint Resolution 4 requests the Congress of the United States to call a constitutional convention for the sole purpose of proposing an amendment to the constitution that would limit corporate personhood for the purposes of campaign finance and political speech and would declare that money does not constitute speech and may be legislatively limited.
