21	environmentally sound containers that also have the advantage		
22	of being able to be resealed, allowing consumers to drink		
23	smaller portions of beer at a time; and		
24	WHEREAS, the sale of craft beer in growlers represents		
25	anywhere from six percent to twenty percent of craft brewery
