11	AMENDING THE HOUSE RULES TO REQUIRE THAT BILLS AND RESOLUTIONS		
12	BE REFERRED TO AT LEAST TWO COMMITTEES, TO IMPOSE WAITING		
13	PERIODS BEFORE BILLS AND RESOLUTIONS ARE READ A THIRD TIME AND		
14	TO REQUIRE THAT ALL ROLL CALL VOTES BE POSTED ON THE INTERNET.

16	WHEREAS, House Rule 24-1 provides that the rules of the		
17	house may be amended by a two-thirds' vote of the members of		
18	the house or by a majority vote of the members of the house		
19	upon the recommendation of the house rules and order of		
20	business committee;		
21	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF		
22	REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the following		
23	house rules be amended to read:		
24	"11-14 At the time of second reading <u>of a bill or</u>		
25	resolution, or upon receipt of a bill or

1		resolution from the senate, or any time
2		thereafter, [if the bill originated in the
3		house] the speaker [should] <u>shall</u> refer it to
4		[a standing committee; but if it was received
5		from the senate, the bill shall be referred to
6		the appropriate committee] no fewer than two
7		substantive standing committees. No bill or
8		[joint] resolution shall be amended or referred
9		to a committee, except for the committee
10		referrals made pursuant to prefiling, until it
11		has been read twice by title.";
12	"11-20-1	When a bill, resolution or memorial is reported
13		by a committee recommending passage and if the
14		report is adopted by the house, all amendments
15		offered by the committee shall be deemed
16		amendments to the bill, resolution or memorial,
17		and it shall be placed on the speaker's table
18		for one calendar day <u>unless it has been</u>
19		referred to a subsequent committee. Upon the
20		expiration of the one calendar day, the bill,
21		resolution or memorial shall be placed on the
22		calendar to be taken up on third reading in its
23		regular order. [provided, however, that the
24		automatic placing of each bill, resolution or
25		memorial on the speaker's table for one

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1		calendar day shall not apply during the last
2		eight legislative days of any session and shall
3		not apply to the placing of bills, resolutions
4		and memorials on the consent calendar.] No
5		bill, except general appropriation bills, or
6		resolution shall be read a third time until
7		twenty-four hours have elapsed since the bill
8		or resolution was reported by or discharged
9		from the last committee to which it was
10		referred. No general appropriation bill shall
11		be read a third time until thirty-six hours
12		have elapsed since the bill was reported by or
13		discharged from the last committee to which it
14		was referred."; and
15	"21-8	The majority and minority floor leaders and
16		whips shall receive a copy of every printed
17		roll call vote taken [on the electronic voting
18		<pre>machine] electronically. Any member [upon</pre>
19		request to the speaker, shall be entitled to]
20		<u>may</u> receive a copy of a printed roll call of
21		the vote taken on the electronic voting
22		machine. In no case, however, shall the
23		declaration of the vote by the speaker be
24		delayed by a request for a copy of the printed
25		roll call. <u>Each printed roll call vote shall</u>
