Honorable President Pro Tempore Papen and Members of the Senate:

Pursuant to the Constitution of the State of New Mexico, Article IV, Section 22, I hereby VETO and return SENATE BILL 36, as amended, enacted by the Fifty-Second Legislature, Second Session, 2016.

Regarding the Developmental Disabilities Medicaid Home and Community-Based Waiver Program, the program Director, the Secretary of the Human Services Department, and the Secretary of the Department of Health are—and have been—available to present and discuss this information with legislators and the appropriate legislative committees. Mandating yet another annual written report in state law is unnecessary and could take away from devoting our scarce resources to meeting the needs of the developmentally disabled.
