five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to plan, design, construct, renovate and improve the exhibits and facility at the museum of Indian arts and culture in Santa Fe in Santa Fe county

- to the public education department

ALB SIGN LANGUAGE ACADEMY CONSTRUCT

six hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$650,000) to plan, design and construct a facility for the Albuquerque sign language academy in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county

INTRNATL SCHL AT MESA DEL SOL CONSTRUCT/RENOVATE

one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) to plan, design, construct, renovate, furnish and equip the buildings and grounds for the international school at Mesa del Sol, including the purchase and installation of fencing, information technology and related equipment, furniture and infrastructure, in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county

four hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$450,000) to construct the convention building, including purchase and installation of furnishings and equipment, in the To'hajiilee chapter of the Navajo Nation in Bernalillo county

one hundred forty-four thousand eight hundred fifteen dollars (\$144,815) to construct and equip a playground and park for a community services campus in the Pueblo of Laguna in Cibola county

two hundred sixty-four thousand two hundred eighty-eight dollars (\$264,288) to replace the public safety building roof in the Pueblo of Laguna in Cibola county

RAMAH CHP CHAPTER HOUSE

two million four hundred thousand dollars (\$2,400,000) to acquire easements and rights of way and to plan, design and construct a chapter house in the Ramah chapter of the Navajo Nation in Cibola county

RAMAH CHP LIVESTOCK TRAINING FCLTY

one million one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$1,175,000) to design, construct, equip and furnish, including the purchase and installation of information technology and related furniture and infrastructure, a livestock training facility of the Ramah chapter of the Navajo Nation in Cibola county

three hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) to plan, design and construct a solid waste transfer station, including a trash compactor dumpster, a trash bin and an operator building, in the Ramah chapter of the Navajo Nation in Cibola county
