## A MEMORIAL

REQUESTING MUNICIPAL OFFICIALS TO DESIGN A SERIES OF RECOMMENDATIONS FOR STATEWIDE EFFICIENT RESIDENTIAL WATER USE.

WHEREAS, with recurrent drought conditions, the need for efficient use of water in New Mexico is a well-recognized fact; and

WHEREAS, urban water use in New Mexico will rise as the 9 population increases, and the bureau of business and economic 10 research at the university of New Mexico estimates that the 11 population of New Mexico will increase to two million five 12 hundred forty thousand one hundred forty-five by 2020 and 13 three million seven hundred ten thousand eight hundred 14 15 seventy-five by 2060, with the fastest-growing regions in and around the urban centers along the middle and lower Rio 16 Grande; and 17

18 WHEREAS, municipalities have actively worked to enhance 19 water conservation efforts and have developed aggressive 20 conservation programs resulting in significant water savings 21 already achieved by these water providers; and

WHEREAS, efficient residential water use helps to mitigate the effects of drought and lessens the depletion of existing water sources and dependency on the development of new water sources, in addition to lowering the water, sewer

HM 15 Page 1 and energy bills of the residential user, thus reducing water utility operating costs; and
