Honorable President Pro Tempore Papen and Members of the Senate:

Pursuant to the Constitution of the State of New Mexico, Article IV, Section 22, I hereby VETO and return SENATE BILL 275, as amended, enacted by the Fifty-Third Legislature, First Session, 2017.

My administration's economic development and diversification initiatives have allowed our massage therapy industry to thrive. However, I cannot support a bill that threatens to undermine the progress that our massage therapy industry has made and lower the standards expected of our massage therapists. SB 275 is short-sighted and would adversely impact the massage therapy industry in the long-term by altering the instructional standards that our massage therapists are held to.

For these reasons, I hereby veto SB 275.
