BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Joint Memorial 11 (SJM11) requests the Public Education Department (PED) and the Department of Health (DOH) gather and provide information to the Legislative Education Study Committee (LESC) to develop a plan for increased physical education instruction in New Mexico elementary schools.

FISCAL IMPACT

Joint memorials do not contain appropriations.

The cost of fully funding physical education statewide is unclear. Attachment A, summarized below, uses FY17 funded student membership (MEM) to estimate the cost of fully funding physical education statewide. The total cost is best understood as being somewhere between \$21.7 million and \$27.8 million, given that it is unclear how many or which school districts and charter schools include grade 6 in elementary school.

SUBSTANTIVE ISSUES

Obesity continues to be a major challenge for children and physical educators in New Mexico and nationwide. The Second Session of the 52nd Legislature (2016) passed SJM2, authorizing the creation of a task force of physical education representatives and researchers to assess issues surrounding physical education in New Mexico and evaluate the feasibility of requiring 150 minutes of physical education per week. During the interim, the task force compiled research from various sources and reported its results to LESC.

Research compiled by the task force shows physical education has a tremendous impact on the physical, emotional, and cognitive development of children. In November, representatives from elementary schools, the Society of Health and Physical Educators, the New Mexico Athletic Directors Association, experts in physical education pedagogy, and health care professionals reported to LESC, describing how students who receive physical education have increased brain activity, higher test scores, better in-class behavior, and better health habits later in life.

The task force also identified that a lack of detailed physical education data in New Mexico represents a significant barrier to crafting an effective physical education plan. The task force identified several gaps in current data:

- First, policymakers need to know how regularly children are currently attending physical education in New Mexico. The task force was not able to assess the amount of time per week children spend in physical education.
- Second, policymakers need information about which schools offer physical education programs, and how often they are offered. It is likely that districts will differ in their approach to physical education, but this data is not currently available.
- Finally, policymakers need information on which schools receive physical education funding, and how this funding is used to serve the students.

OTHER SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

An LESC analysis on this memorial's predecessor noted that, in 2007, the Legislature passed and the governor signed House Bill 208 establishing specific program units for physical education to be added to the state equalization guarantee. The plan would have phased in physical education completely by 2011, but could not be completed due to lack of funds. LESC staff found appropriations made in FY07 and FY08 funded about half of the elementary schools in New Mexico.

RELATED BILLS

Related to SB241, School Visual Arts & Physical Ed Standards, which would adopt federal standards for physical education and the arts.
