### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 420 amends Section 66-5-205 NMSA 1978 to allow the Taxation and Revenue Department to establish rules requiring law enforcement officers to accept proof of financial responsibility that is displayed on a software application on a mobile device.

### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

No fiscal impact.

### TECHNICAL ISSUES

Consider, on page 2, line 10, after “mobile”, insert “communication” to conform to definition found in Section 66-5-1.1 NMSA 1978 of “mobile communication device”. Additionally, no definition exists in this section of law for “software application”.
