FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

There were estimated to be more than 56,000 New Mexico grandchildren in the care of their grandparents in the year 2010, when the census was done. More than half of the grandparents involved lived in poverty, with the care of their grandchildren adding another burden. Many of these children would be in CYFD care if it were not for the grandparents.

RELATIONSHIP with House Memorial 58 and Senate Memorial 92, almost identical memorials that would continue the existence of the Grandparents Raising Grandchildren Taskforce for another year.
