NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico legislative council be requested to convene a task force to review and study the legislative process in New Mexico; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the New Mexico legislative council be requested to appoint members from the house of representatives and the senate and public members to the task .206631.1
