WHEREAS, the department of game and fish is charged with ensuring that fur-bearing animals are not wasted or depleted; and

10 WHEREAS, there is a diverse interest in the management of 11 fur-bearing and non-game animals in the state; and

WHEREAS, the shared and safe use of public lands is important to New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, it would be beneficial for the department of game and fish to enter into a dialogue with constituents regarding current trapping practices used to harvest both fur-bearing and non-game animals on public land;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the department of game and fish be requested to engage in a dialogue with interested constituents regarding the future of trapping in New Mexico; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the department of game and fish be requested to seek input and participation from constituents for an adequate and flexible system of managing fur-bearing and non-game animals on public lands and for the .207466.1
