11	PROPOSING TO AMEND ARTICLE 11, SECTION 1 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF
12	NEW MEXICO TO PROVIDE FOR A THREE-MEMBER PUBLIC REGULATION
13	COMMISSION APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR WITH THE ADVICE AND
14	CONSENT OF THE SENATE IN LIEU OF THE CURRENT FIVE-MEMBER
15	ELECTED COMMISSION.
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17	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
18	SECTION 1. It is proposed to amend Article 11, Section 1
19	of the constitution of New Mexico to read:
20	"The "public regulation commission" is created. The
21	commission shall consist of [five] <u>three</u> members [elected from
22	districts provided by law for staggered four-year terms
23	beginning on January 1 of the year following their election;
24	provided that those chosen at the first general election after
25	the adoption of this section shall immediately classify
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1	themselves by lot, so that two of them shall hold office for
2	two years and three of them for four years; and further
3	provided that, after serving two terms, members shall be
4	ineligible to hold office as a commission member until one full
5	term has intervened] appointed by the governor with the advice
6	and consent of the senate, from districts as provided by law;
7	provided that the initial districts from which the appointments
8	are made following the adoption of this amendment shall be the
9	same as the state's congressional districts. No more than two
10	commissioners shall be members of the same political party at
11	the time of their appointment. Commissioners shall be
12	appointed for staggered four-year terms; provided that two of
13	the first three commissioners appointed shall be appointed to a
14	two-year term and the third shall be appointed to a four-year
15	term. Commissioners are state officers. The legislature shall
16	provide, by law, [increased] qualifications [for commissioners]
17	and continuing education requirements for commissioners. [The
18	increased qualifications provided by this 2012 amendment shall
19	apply to public regulation commissioners elected at the general
20	election in 2014 and subsequent elections and to commissioners
21	appointed to fill a vacancy at any time after July 1, 2013.]
22	No commissioner [or candidate for the commission] shall accept
23	anything of value from a person or entity whose charges for
24	services to the public are regulated by the commission."
25	SECTION 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution

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	1	shall be submitted to the people for their approval or
	2	rejection at the next general election or at any special
	3	election prior to that date that may be called for that
	4	purpose.
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
