AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC SCHOOLS; LIMITING CHARTER SCHOOL STUDENT PARTICIPATION IN SCHOOL DISTRICT ACTIVITIES TO THE ATTENDANCE ZONE IN WHICH THE STUDENT RESIDES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

**SECTION 1.** Section 22-8-23.6 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2006, Chapter 94, Section 15) is amended to read:

"22-8-23.6. CHARTER SCHOOL STUDENT ACTIVITIES PROGRAM UNIT.--The charter school student activities program unit for a school district is determined by multiplying the number of

charter school students who are participating in school district activities governed by the New Mexico activities association by the cost differential factor of 0.1. The student activities program unit shall be paid to the school district in which it is generated. A charter school student is eligible to participate in school district activities at the public school in the attendance zone in which the student resides, according to the New Mexico activities association guidelines. [~~If the student chooses to participate at a public school other than the one in the attendance zone in which the student resides, the student shall be subject to New Mexico activities association transfer guidelines.~~]"

HEC→SECTION 2. APPLICABILITY.--The provisions of this act apply to charter school students entering the ninth grade in the 2018-2019 school year and subsequent school years. ←HEC

SECTION HEC→2 3←HEC. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2018.
