MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE CRIME VICTIMS REPARATION  
COMMISSION TO CREATE CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE PROGRAMS THROUGHOUT THE  
STATE SPAC→**AND TO PROVIDE FOR A STATEWIDE COORDINATOR TO WORK

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

**SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.**--Seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the crime victims reparation commission for expenditure in fiscal year 2019 to create child sexual abuse programs throughout the
