11 RELATING TO PROFESSIONAL AND OCCUPATIONAL LICENSES; PROHIBITING  
12 REQUIRING RESUBMISSION OF FINGERPRINTS AFTER ISSUE OF LICENSE.  
13

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

15 SECTION 1. A new section of the Uniform Licensing Act is  
16 enacted to read:

17 "[NEW MATERIAL] FINGERPRINTS NOT REQUIRED FOR LICENSE  
18 RENEWAL.--Where a professional or occupational board requires  
19 submission of fingerprints as part of the initial license  
20 application, and a licensee has provided fingerprints and the  
21 license has been issued, the board shall not require a licensee  
22 to submit fingerprints again to renew the license, but a  
23 licensee shall submit to a background investigation if  
24 required."
