

1 A MEMORIAL

2 DECLARING JANUARY 25, 2018 "SANTA FE COUNTY DAY" IN THE HOUSE
3 OF REPRESENTATIVES.

5 WHEREAS, in 1852, Santa Fe county was established as one
6 of the first counties in the United States territory of New
7 Mexico; and

8 WHEREAS, Santa Fe county has within its boundaries the
9 local government jurisdictions of the city of Espanola, the
10 city of Santa Fe and the town of Edgewood; and

11 WHEREAS, Santa Fe county has within its boundaries the
12 tribal government jurisdictions of the Pueblo of Santa Clara,
13 the Pueblo of San Ildefonso, the Pueblo of Nambe, the Pueblo
14 of Pojoaque, the Pueblo of Tesuque, the Pueblo of Cochiti and
15 the Pueblo of Santo Domingo; and

16 WHEREAS, Santa Fe county also encompasses many long-
17 inhabited traditional communities extending from the north to
18 the south of the county; and

19 WHEREAS, county residents are governed by publicly
20 elected officials on the board of county commissioners, the
21 county clerk, the county assessor, the county treasurer, the
22 county probate judge and the county sheriff; and

23 WHEREAS, the Santa Fe county government and its elected
24 officials work to be inclusive of all persons and authorities
25 in the county to utilize resources to best provide services

1 for everyone; and

2 WHEREAS, Santa Fe county honors and promotes the strong
3 traditions and multicultural history of New Mexico;

4 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
5 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that Santa Fe
6 county residents, past and present, be recognized for their
7 contributions in creating an inclusive environment honoring
8 the county's diverse cultures and traditions; and

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that January 25, 2018 be declared
10 "Santa Fe County Day" in the house of representatives; and

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
12 transmitted to the Santa Fe county board of county
13 commissioners, the mayor of the city of Espanola, the mayor of
14 the city of Santa Fe, the mayor of the town of Edgewood and
15 the governors of the Pueblo of Santa Clara, the Pueblo of San
16 Ildefonso, the Pueblo of Nambe, the Pueblo of Pojoaque, the
17 Pueblo of Tesuque, the Pueblo of Cochiti and the Pueblo of
18 Santo Domingo.
