SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 223 appropriates \$25 million from the general fund to the Department of Health to fund supports and services for individuals enrolled in a developmental disability Medicaid homeand community-based waiver program and to allow enrollment of eligible individuals listed on the Department of Health's central registry who are currently awaiting allocation of supports and services through the developmental disability Medicaid waiver program.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$25 million contained in this bill is a recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of FY19 shall revert to the general fund.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

At the end of FY17, there were 6,602 individuals on the Department of Health's central registry (waiting list) and an individual can wait more than 10 years waiting to be allocated on to the waiver.
