#### Synopsis of Memorial

Senate Memorial 113 requests the New Mexico congressional delegation to enact legislation to establish a system of checks and balances on the authority to use nuclear weapons, provided the president retain sole authority for the use of the weapon in retaliation to an attack upon the United States or its allies.
