SENATE FLOOR AMENDMENT number _____ to SENATE BILL 8, as amended

Amendment sponsored by Senator William E. Sharer

1. On page 1, line 12, after the semicolon, insert "PROVIDING IMMUNITY;".

2. On page 3, between lines 8 and 9, insert a new section to read:

"SECTION 2. [NEW MATERIAL] IMMUNITY.--A transferor of a firearm who engages the services of a federal firearms licensee to conduct a federal instant background check prior to the sale of a firearm or a federal firearms licensee who conducts a federal instant background check prior to the sale of a firearm is immune from civil liability from the time of the transfer for any use of the firearm, unless the transferor or federal firearms licensee knows, or reasonably should know, that the transferee is likely to commit an unlawful act involving the firearm or intends to deliver the firearm to a third person who the transferor or federal firearms licensee knows, or reasonably should know, is prohibited from purchasing or receiving the firearm."

3. Renumber the succeeding section accordingly.
