16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	SECTION 1. Section 66-7-332 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978,
18	Chapter 35, Section 436, as amended) is amended to read:
19	"66-7-332. OPERATION OF VEHICLES ON APPROACH OF MOVING
20	AUTHORIZED EMERGENCY VEHICLESOPERATION OF VEHICLES [ <del>ON</del>
21	APPROACH OF] UPON APPROACHING CERTAIN STATIONARY VEHICLES
22	A. Upon the immediate approach of an authorized
23	emergency vehicle displaying flashing emergency lights or when
24	the driver is giving audible signal by siren, the driver of
25	every other vehicle shall yield the right of way and shall

1 immediately drive to a position parallel to, and as close as 2 possible to, the right-hand edge or curb of the roadway clear 3 of any intersection and shall stop and remain in that position 4 until the authorized emergency vehicle has passed, except when otherwise directed by a police officer.

Β. Upon approaching a stationary [authorized emergency vehicle or a recovery or repair] vehicle displaying flashing emergency or hazard lights, unless otherwise directed, the driver of a vehicle shall:

if reasonably safe to do so, drive in (1) a lane not adjacent to the stationary vehicle, decrease the speed of the vehicle to a speed that is ten miles per hour lower than the posted speed limit or to a speed that is reasonable and prudent under the circumstances and proceed with caution; or

if it is not reasonably safe to drive (2) in a lane not adjacent to the stationary vehicle, decrease the speed of the vehicle to a speed that is ten miles per hour lower than the posted speed limit or to a speed that is reasonable and prudent under the circumstances, proceed with caution and be prepared to stop.

This section shall not operate to relieve the C. driver of an authorized emergency vehicle or the driver of any other vehicle from the duty to drive and park with due regard for the safety of all persons using the highway.

24	E. Upon a third or subsequent conviction for	
25	failure to yield pursuant to Section 66-7-332 NMSA 1978, the

[E.] F. Upon a second conviction for operation without a permit for excessive size or weight pursuant to Section 66-7-413 NMSA 1978, the penalty assessment shall be two hundred fifty dollars (\$250). Upon a third or subsequent conviction, the penalty assessment shall be five hundred dollars (\$500).

[F-] <u>G.</u> Upon a second conviction for transport of a reducible load with a permit for excessive size or weight pursuant to Subsection N of Section 66-7-413 NMSA 1978 more than six miles from a port-of-entry facility on the border with Mexico, the penalty assessment shall be five hundred dollars (\$500). Upon a third or subsequent conviction, the penalty assessment shall be one thousand dollars (\$1,000)."
