Mr. Speaker:

Your JUDICIARY COMMITTEE, to whom has been referred
HOUSE BILL 414

has had it under consideration and reports same with recommendation that it DO PASS, amended as follows:

- 1. On page 2, line 17, after the subsection designation "A.", strike "A" and insert in lieu thereof "Except as provided pursuant to Subsection C of this section, a".
- 2. On page 3, line 16, strike the closing quotation mark.
- 3. On page 3, between lines 16 and 17, insert the following new subsections:
- "C. The provisions of this section shall not apply to circumstances in which a nursing facility is involuntarily closed due to termination of the nursing facility's participation in medicare or medicaid by state or federal authorities.
 - D. As used in this section:
- (1) "medicaid" means the joint federal-state health coverage program pursuant to Title 19 or Title 21 of the federal Social Security Act and rules promulgated pursuant to that act; and
- (2) "medicare" means health coverage provided pursuant to the federal Health Insurance for the Aged Act, Title 18 of the federal Social Security Amendments of 1965, as then constituted or later amended."".
