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AN ACT
RELATING TO CAPITAL EXPENDITURES; REAUTHORIZING OR
REAPPROPRIATING BALANCES, EXPANDING, CLARIFYING OR CHANGING
PURPOSES, EXTENDING EXPENDITURE PERIODS, CHANGING AGENCIES
AND ESTABLISHING CONDITIONS FOR THE REVERSION OR TRANSFER OF
UNEXPENDED BALANCES OF APPROPRIATIONS MADE BY THE LEGISLATURE
IN PRIOR YEARS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDS--REVERSION OF

PROCEEDS.--

A. Except as otherwise provided in another section
of this act:

(1) the unexpended balance from the proceeds
of severance tax bonds issued for a project that has been
reauthorized in this act shall revert to the severance tax
bonding fund:

(a) at the end of the expenditure
period as set forth in this act, if the expenditure period is
changed in this act; or

(b) if the expenditure period is not
changed in this act, pursuant to the time frame set forth in
the law that originally authorized the severance tax bonds or
the time frame set forth in any law that has previously
reauthorized the expenditure of the proceeds, whichever is

1 later; and

2 (2) all remaining balances from the proceeds
3 of severance tax bonds issued for a project that has been
4 reauthorized in this act shall revert to the severance tax
5 bonding fund three months after the reversion date for the
6 unexpended balances.

7 B. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
8 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
9 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding
10 written obligations to third parties.

11 SECTION 2. GENERAL FUND AND OTHER FUND
12 APPROPRIATIONS--REVERSIONS.--

13 A. Except as otherwise provided in another section
14 of this act:

15 (1) the unexpended balance of an
16 appropriation from the general fund or other state fund that
17 has been changed in this act shall revert:

18 (a) at the end of the expenditure
19 period as set forth in this act, if the expenditure period is
20 changed in this act; or

21 (b) if the expenditure period is not
22 changed in this act, pursuant to the time frame set forth in
23 the law in which the original appropriation was made or the
24 time frame set forth in any law that has previously changed
25 the appropriation, whichever is later; and

1 (2) all remaining balances of an
2 appropriation from the general fund or other state fund that
3 has been changed in this act shall revert three months after
4 the reversion date for the unexpended balance.

5 B. Except as provided in Subsection C of this
6 section, the balance of an appropriation made from the
7 general fund or other state fund shall revert pursuant to
8 Subsection A of this section to the originating fund.

9 C. The balance of an appropriation made from the
10 general fund or other state fund to the Indian affairs
11 department or the aging and long-term services department for
12 a project located on lands of an Indian nation, tribe or
13 pueblo shall revert pursuant to Subsection A of this section
14 to the tribal infrastructure project fund.

15 D. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
16 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
17 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding
18 written obligations to third parties.

19 **SECTION 3. ALBUQUERQUE SINGING ARROW COMMUNITY CENTER**
20 **IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of
21 expenditure for the local government division project in
22 Subsection 56 of Section 28 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st
23 S.S.) to acquire land and rights of way for and to plan,
24 design, construct, furnish and equip improvements to the
25 Singing Arrow community center in Albuquerque in Bernalillo

1 county is extended through fiscal year 2021.

2 **SECTION 4. BERNALILLO COUNTY AMISTAD YOUTH CRISIS**
3 **CENTER IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The
4 time of expenditure for the local government division project
5 in Subsection 4 of Section 28 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st
6 S.S.) to plan, design, construct, furnish and equip
7 improvements to the Amistad youth crisis center in the South
8 Valley area of Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal
9 year 2021.

10 **SECTION 5. BERNALILLO COUNTY CARLITO SPRINGS OPEN SPACE**
11 **IMPROVEMENTS PHASES 2 AND 3--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX**
12 **BONDS.--**The time of expenditure for the local government
13 division project in Subsection 5 of Section 28 of Chapter 3
14 of Laws 2015 (1st S.S.) to plan, design, construct, renovate,
15 equip and furnish phase 2 and phase 3 improvements to the
16 Carlito Springs open space area in the East Mountain area of
17 Bernalillo county is extended through fiscal year 2021.

18 **SECTION 6. SOUTH VALLEY COMMONS INFRASTRUCTURE**
19 **CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--**The time of
20 expenditure for the local government division project in
21 Subsection 13 of Section 28 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st
22 S.S.) to plan, design and construct infrastructure at the
23 South Valley commons in Bernalillo county is extended through
24 fiscal year 2021.

3 TAX BONDS.--The unexpended balance of the public education
4 department project in Subsection 18 of Section 15 of Chapter
5 3 of Laws 2015 (1st S.S.) to acquire land for Technology
6 Leadership high school in Bernalillo county shall not be
7 expended for the original purpose but is appropriated to the
8 local government division to plan, design, construct, furnish
9 and equip improvements to the South Valley economic
10 development center in Bernalillo county. The time of
11 expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2021.

12 SECTION 8. SECOND JUDICIAL DISTRICT ATTORNEY SECURITY
13 EQUIPMENT PURCHASE--EXPAND PURPOSE--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The
14 second judicial district attorney project in Laws 2018,
15 Chapter 80, Section 11 to purchase and install security
16 cameras, equipment and related technology for the office of
17 the second judicial district attorney in Albuquerque in
18 Bernalillo county may include planning, designing,
19 constructing and renovating that office.

20 SECTION 9. ALBUQUERQUE ASIAN AMERICAN MONUMENT
21 CONSTRUCTION--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
22 expenditure for the local government division project in
23 Subsection 20 of Section 28 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st
24 S.S.) to plan, design, landscape and construct an Asian
25 American monument in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county is

1 extended through fiscal year 2021.

2 **SECTION 10. ALBUQUERQUE DOWNTOWN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT**
3 **PROJECT CONSTRUCTION--EXPAND PURPOSE--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE**
4 **TAX BONDS.--**The local government division project in
5 Subsection 28 of Section 28 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st
6 S.S.) to plan, design, construct, furnish and equip
7 improvements for economic development projects in downtown
8 Albuquerque in Bernalillo county may include planning,
9 designing, constructing and equipping development projects at
10 the rail yards in downtown Albuquerque. The time of
11 expenditure is extended through fiscal year 2021.

12 **SECTION 11. ALBUQUERQUE EXPLORA SCIENCE CENTER AND**

18 elevator at Amy Biehl high school in Albuquerque in
19 Bernalillo county shall not be expended for the original

3 Chapter 133, Section 27 to design, construct, purchase and
4 install exhibits and to acquire art, artifacts and equipment

7 through fiscal year 2021.

4 consolidated school district in Valencia county shall not be
5 expended for the original purpose but is changed to plan,
6 design, construct, purchase and install security systems and
7 improvements, including security cameras and infrastructure,
8 at the high school. The time of expenditure is extended
9 through fiscal year 2021.

10 SECTION 115. LOS LUNAS SPORTS COMPLEX FACILITY

11 IMPROVEMENTS--EXTEND TIME--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--The time of
12 expenditure for the local government division project in
13 Subsection 242 of Section 28 of Chapter 3 of Laws 2015 (1st
14 S.S.) for design, construction and improvements to a sports
15 complex in Los Lunas in Valencia county is extended through
16 fiscal year 2021.

17 SECTION 116. TOHATCHI CHAPTER POWERLINE

18 EXTENSION--EXTEND TIME--GENERAL FUND.--The time of
19 expenditure for the appropriation originally made to the
20 local government division in Subsection 154 of Section 26 of
21 Chapter 2 of Laws 2007 and reappropriated to the Indian
22 affairs department in Laws 2009, Chapter 128, Section 312 and
23 for which the time of expenditure was extended in Laws 2011,
24 Chapter 183, Section 66 and in Laws 2013, Chapter 202,
25 Section 26 and reauthorized in Laws 2015, Chapter 147,

1 Section 39 and again in Laws 2017, Chapter 133, Section 65 to
2 plan, design and construct powerline extensions in the
3 Tohatchi chapter of the Navajo Nation in McKinley county is
4 extended through fiscal year 2021.
