8	SECTION 1. Section 9-26-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2007,		
9	Chapter 200, Section 1) is amended to read:		
10	"9-26-1. SHORT TITLEChapter 9, Article 26 NMSA 1978		
11	may be cited as the "Workforce Solutions Department Act"."		
12	SECTION 2. A new section of the Workforce Solutions		
13	Department Act is enacted to read:		
14	"CAREER DEVELOPMENT WOMEN IN THE OIL AND GAS		
15	INDUSTRYThe department and the energy, minerals and		
16	natural resources department shall coordinate to:		
17	A. promote programs that:		
18	(1) expand opportunities for women to		
19	develop their skills, continue their education or be		
20	retrained for careers in the oil and gas industry;		
21	(2) connect women with business development		
22	resources to grow or establish oil and gas industry-related		
23	businesses, including the businesses of landman, trucking or

25	(3) engage with businesses in the oil and		

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gas industry to create apprenticeship programs to train and provide work experience to women interested in a career in the industry; and

B. undertake a study to collect statistical data on the number of women employed in the oil and gas industry in New Mexico by ethnicity and occupation. The workforce solutions department shall publish a summary of the statistical data on its website and distribute the summary annually by November 1 to the interim legislative committee that studies labor and employment issues."

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
