

1 A MEMORIAL

2 REQUESTING THE STATE TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION TO NAME THAT
3 PORTION OF UNITED STATES HIGHWAY 285, FROM CLINES CORNERS TO
4 ENCINO, AS THE "LARRY LARRAÑAGA CORRIDOR".

6 WHEREAS, Larry A. Larrañaga, a former legislator who
7 represented house district 27, covering the northeast heights
8 in Albuquerque, from 1995 to 2018, died on October 9, 2018
9 from a rare degenerative brain disorder; and

10 WHEREAS, Representative Larrañaga received a bachelor of
11 science degree and a master's degree in engineering from the
12 university of New Mexico; and

13 WHEREAS, prior to his legislative service,
14 Representative Larrañaga was a cabinet secretary for the
15 state highway and transportation department, now the
16 department of transportation, and a former chief
17 administrative officer for the city of Albuquerque; and

18 WHEREAS, Representative Larrañaga was highly respected
19 by New Mexico leaders across the political spectrum; and

20 WHEREAS, Representative Larrañaga will be remembered for
21 his honesty, integrity, generosity and willingness to serve
22 others and is deserving of having his legacy memorialized;

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
24 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the state
25 transportation commission be requested to name that portion

1 of United States highway 285, from Clines Corners to Encino,
2 as the "Larry Larrañaga Corridor"; and

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this memorial be
4 transmitted to the department of transportation, the board of
5 county commissioners of Torrance county and Larry Larrañaga's
6 widow, Charletta Larrañaga. _____
