8	"22-5-4.8. AREA VOCATIONAL HIGH SCHOOLS
9	A. A local school board, alone or in cooperation
10	with other local school boards, may develop a plan for the
11	establishment of an area vocational high school. The plan
12	shall be submitted to the department for its approval.
13	B. The department may approve a plan for an area
14	vocational high school if the plan adequately provides for:
15	(1) sufficient financing for the operation
16	of the school, which may include an election for a special
17	levy not to exceed one dollar (\$1.00) for each one thousand
18	dollars (\$1,000) of net taxable value, and that may be in
19	addition to levies authorized by the College District Tax
20	Act;
21	(2) a broad vocational and technical
