### SUMMARY

#### Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 100 amends section 12-5-2 NMSA 1978 to change “Columbus” to “Indigenous Peoples”, effectively changing Columbus Day to Indigenous Peoples’ Day.

This bill also amends parts of section 57-12-21 NMSA 1978 to standardize language, as well as change “Columbus” to “Indigenous Peoples”, “Washington’s birthday” to “President’s day” and adds “Armistice day” to the list of business holidays stated in this section.
