## **SUMMARY**

#### Synopsis of Bill

House Bill amends the Motor Vehicle Code to include the definition of an electric foot scooter, excludes an electric foot scooter from being included in the definition of moped, motorcycle and motor vehicle, excludes an electric foot scooter from registration. It proposes a new section (66-3-1104) allowing operators of electric foot scooters to be granted rights of bicyclists and allows parking of sidewalks in a manner that does not impede pedestrians or other traffic.
