Synopsis of SfI#1 Amendment

The Senate Floor amendment to Senate Bill 351 declares Guadalupe Hidalgo Treaty Day *at the Legislature*.

Synopsis of Original Bill

House Bill 351 adds a provision the statute declaring Guadalupe Hidalgo Treaty Day providing that in years in which February 2nd falls on a weekend, the holiday is observed the following Monday.
