SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

House Bill 614 adds new material to the Public School Insurance Authority Act exempting from inspection the following records:

- (1) Records pertaining to insurance coverage provided that any record of a particular coverage shall be available to a public officer, public employee, or governmental entity insured under such coverage; and
- (2) Records pertaining to claims for damages or other relief against any governmental entity or public officer or employee provided that such records shall be subject to public inspection by New Mexico residents 180 days after the latest of the following dates:
- (a) The date all statutes of limitation applicable to the claim have run;
- (b) The date all litigation involving the claim and the occurrence giving rise thereto has been brought to final judgment and all appeals and rights to appeal have been exhausted;
- (c) The date the claim is fully and finally settled; or
- (d) The date the claim has been placed on closed status.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

There will likely be no fiscal impact resulting from enactment of HB614.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

HB614 provides NMPSIA the same exemptions from the Inspection of Public Records Act as the General Services Department (GSD). The existing GSD statute is ambiguous and leads to confusion as to when records should be released. If enacted, it is likely HB614 would create similar issues for PSIA settlements.
