#### Synopsis of Memorial

Senate Memorial 68 requests the Corrections Department and the Workforce Solutions Department conduct a feasibility study over the 2019 interim period to determine what steps can be taken to help newly released inmates find transitional housing and employment with the goal of better reintegration into society and lower recidivism rates.

Senate Memorial 68 requests a report on findings to the appropriate interim committee by October 1, 2019.
