Synopsis of Memorial

Senate Memorial 87 (SM 87) affirms the commitment of the New Mexico State Senate to constitutional civil rights and equality under the law by resolving:

- 1. that proud American citizens are heirs to the sacred legacy entrusted by the nation's founders;
- 2. that the senate of the state of New Mexico has a moral obligation to preserve, protect and defend the United States constitution, with its promise of equal protection under the law;
- 3. and that the senate of the state of New Mexico stands against discrimination of any kind against anyone on the basis of race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, religious belief, political ideology or any other characteristic.

The memorial also requests that a copy of SM87 be sent to the governor.
