WHEREAS, the public regulation commission is responsible for regulating public utilities, including electric, natural gas and water companies; transportation companies, including common and contract carriers; transmission and pipeline companies; including telephone, telegraph and information transmission companies and other public service companies, and there is no mention of the needed focus or support to ensure adequate fire services statewide; and

WHEREAS, statewide representatives with technical and operational expertise about fire services should be actively engaged in determining the needs and objectives of fire services; and

WHEREAS, the fire marshal division should be relocated either as a standalone entity or as an administratively attached entity in an appropriate state department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the New Mexico municipal league and New Mexico counties be requested to convene a working group to evaluate relocation options for the fire marshal division of the public regulation commission; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group be composed of representatives of the:
