BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

SECTION 1. A new section of the HHHC→Group Benefits←HHHC

HHHC→Health Care Purchasing←HHHC Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] PHARMACIST PRESCRIPTIVE AUTHORITY SERVICES--REIMBURSEMENT PARITY.--A Hf12→HHHHC→group health plan←HHHC Hf12→A group health plan←Hf12 Hf12→HHHC→Group health care coverage, including any form of self-insurance offered, issued or renewed under the Health Care Purchasing Act,←HHHC←Hf12 shall not discriminate with respect to reimbursement under the group health plan against a Hfll→participating provider that is a←Hfll certified pharmacist clinician or pharmacist certified to provide a prescriptive authority service who is acting within the scope of certification. not discriminate with respect to reimbursement pursuant to a

subscriber contract that is delivered, issued for delivery or

that is a←Hf11 certified pharmacist clinician or pharmacist

certified to provide a prescriptive authority service who is

acting within the scope of certification. The←Hf12 health care
