A MEMORIAL

REQUESTING THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO STUDY AND PROVIDE RECOMMENDATIONS ON INSTITUTING OPEN PRIMARY ELECTIONS.

WHEREAS, increasing participation in all levels of the political process will produce a stronger mandate to govern; and

WHEREAS, twenty-five percent of all New Mexico voters choose not to affiliate with a major political party; and WHEREAS, sixty percent of younger voters choose to be

independent voters; and

WHEREAS, voters' tax dollars should not fund elections those voters cannot participate in; and

WHEREAS, New Mexico as a state has among the lowest rate of voter turnout and the highest rate of non-competitive elections in the country; and

WHEREAS, increasing participation in all levels of the political process will strengthen democracy and provide increased civil discourse; SRC→and←SRC

SRC WHEREAS, semi-open primaries allow non-affiliated voters to participate exclusively in one primary and increase the responsiveness of primary candidates to their communities; and

WHEREAS, denying participation in primary elections is a form of disenfranchisement;←SRC

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the secretary of state be requested to study open primaries, in their various forms, and develop recommendations on instituting a form of open primaries in the state; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the secretary of state provide recommendations for legislation to open New Mexico's primary elections to the appropriate interim legislative committee before November 1, 2020; and
