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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	SECTION 1. Section 59A-2-2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1984,
18	Chapter 127, Section 20, as amended) is amended to read:
19	"59A-2-2. SUPERINTENDENTAPPOINTMENTTERM
20	COMPENSATIONREMOVAL
21	A. The position of superintendent of insurance
22	shall be the chief officer of the office of superintendent of
23	insurance.
24	B. The superintendent shall be appointed by the
25	insurance nominating committee.
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C. The superintendent shall serve for a term of four years, except that the initial term beginning July 1, 2013 shall end on December 31, 2015. [If the position of superintendent becomes vacant, the successor shall serve for the remainder of the term] An incumbent superintendent may apply to the insurance nominating committee for appointment to additional terms.

The superintendent's annual compensation shall D. be subject to legislative appropriation and established by the insurance nominating committee at the start of each term and 10 annually thereafter. The superintendent's annual compensation 12 shall be no lower than that of the lowest-compensated cabinet secretary and no higher than that of the highest-compensated cabinet secretary.

The superintendent shall not be removed except Ε. for incompetence, willful neglect of duty or malfeasance in The insurance nominating committee may remove the office. superintendent after providing the superintendent with notice and a hearing."

Section 59A-2-2.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2013, SECTION 2. Chapter 74, Section 15, as amended) is amended to read:

"59A-2-2.1. INSURANCE NOMINATING COMMITTEE--DUTIES--ADMINISTRATIVE ATTACHMENT .--

The "insurance nominating committee" is created Α. and consists of nine members, including:

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1	(1) four members who are selected by the New
2	Mexico legislative council as follows:
3	(a) two members who shall represent the
4	interests of the insurance industry;
5	(b) two members who shall represent the
6	interests of insurance consumers and who have experience
7	advocating on behalf of consumers or the public interest on
8	insurance issues. These consumer members shall not be employed
9	by or on behalf of or have a contract with an employer that is
10	regulated by the office of superintendent of insurance; and
11	(c) no more than two of the four members
12	shall be from the same political party;
13	(2) four members who are selected by the
14	governor as follows:
15	(a) two members who shall represent the
16	interests of the insurance industry;
17	(b) two members who shall represent the
18	interests of insurance consumers and who have experience
19	advocating on behalf of consumers or the public interest on
20	insurance issues. These consumer members shall not be employed
21	by or on behalf of or have a contract with an employer that is
22	regulated by the office of superintendent of insurance; and
23	(c) no more than two of the four members
24	shall be from the same political party; and
25	(3) a ninth member who shall be chair of the
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1 committee and who shall be selected by a majority of the other 2 eight members; provided that the member shall: (a) not be a candidate for the position 3 of superintendent of insurance; and 4 (b) be either a former New Mexico 5 superintendent of insurance or another person with extensive 6 7 knowledge of insurance regulation in New Mexico, but does not 8 have, nor have a spouse or child who has, any direct financial 9 interest in an insurer, insurance agency or insurance transaction except as a policyholder or a claimant under a 10 policy or as an owner of less than one percent of the shares of 11 12 an insurer that is a publicly traded corporation. A vacancy on the committee shall be filled by Β. 13 14 the original appointing authority for the remainder of the term. 15 A committee member shall: C. 16 be a resident of New Mexico; 17 (1)(2) serve a four-year term; except that a 18 member of the first committee appointed shall serve for a term 19 20 that ends on June 30, 2015; and (3) serve without compensation, but shall be 21 eligible to receive per diem and mileage pursuant to the 22 Per Diem and Mileage Act. 23 The committee is subject to the Inspection of D. 24 Public Records Act and the Open Meetings Act. 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members of the committee are subject to the Governmental
Conduct Act and the Financial Disclosure Act.

E. The committee shall convene within ninety days [prior to the date on which the term of a superintendent ends and shall appoint a superintendent within sixty days of convening] in anticipation of the occurrence of a vacancy in the superintendent position or the expiration of a superintendent's term of office.

9 F. Upon the occurrence of a vacancy in the superintendent position, [the committee shall convene within 10 thirty days of the date of the vacancy and shall appoint a 11 12 successor to fill the remainder of the superintendent's term within sixty days of convening] or after the conclusion of the 13 superintendent's term, the chair of the committee may appoint 14 an interim superintendent who shall serve until a successor is 15 duly qualified. 16

G. The committee shall actively solicit, accept and evaluate applications from qualified individuals for the position of superintendent and may require an applicant to submit any information it deems relevant to the consideration of the individual's application.

H. The committee shall appoint the superintendent by a vote of a majority of all members of the committee.

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I. The committee shall meet no less often than annually.

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1 J. The committee is administratively attached to 2 the office of superintendent of insurance. The office of 3 superintendent of insurance shall provide staff for the 4 committee. К. An employee of the office of superintendent of 5 insurance who serves as staff for the committee shall not 6 7 reveal to any person, except another committee staff person, any requests or statements disclosed in confidence by a 8 9 committee member, except that this restriction shall not apply to any disclosure that is: 10 (1) protected under the Whistleblower 11 12 Protection Act; or required by law." 13 (2)SECTION 3. Section 59A-2-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1984, 14 Chapter 127, Section 21, as amended) is amended to read: 15 "59A-2-3. SUPERINTENDENT--QUALIFICATIONS AND BOND.--The 16 17 superintendent shall: [A. be a resident of New Mexico at the time of 18 19 appointment; 20 B.] A. be bonded as provided in the Surety Bond 21 Act; [C.] B. not have a direct financial interest in an 22 insurer, insurance agency or insurance transaction except as a 23 policyholder or a claimant under a policy or as an owner of 24 less than one percent of the shares of an insurer that is a 25 .216767.1GLG

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1	publicly traded corporation; and
2	[D.] <u>C.</u> not have a spouse who:
3	(1) has a direct financial interest in an
4	insurer or insurance agency regulated by the office of
5	superintendent of insurance, except as an owner of less than
6	one percent of the shares of an insurer that is a publicly
7	traded corporation; or
8	(2) is licensed as an individual by the office
9	of superintendent of insurance."
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
