20	A. A public school student shall have at least a

25	section, "grading period" is a period of time not less than six

1 The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to weeks. 2 students receiving C or D level special education services. Except as provided in Subsection C of this 3 Β. section, a student shall not be absent from school for 4 interscholastic extracurricular activities in excess of fifteen 5 days per semester, and no class shall be missed in excess of 6 7 fifteen times per semester for interscholastic extracurricular

activities.

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9 C. A student who maintains a 3.0 grade point average or better on a 4.0 scale, or its equivalent, either 10 cumulatively or for the grading period immediately preceding a 11 12 request for absence for interscholastic extracurricular activities, may miss more than fifteen days or fifteen periods 13 of the same class per semester in a school year for 14 participation in interscholastic extracurricular activities if 15 approved by the student's parent, the student's teacher and the 16 school principal. 17

[G.] D. The secretary may issue a waiver relating to the number of absences for participation in any state or national competition that is not an interscholastic extracurricular activity. The secretary shall develop a procedure for petitioning cumulative provision eligibility cases, similar to other eligibility situations.
