#### **SUMMARY**

#### Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 229 appropriates \$2 million from the general fund to the Local Government division of the DFA for the City of Albuquerque to contract with a nonprofit organization to provide housing and renovations to housing for survivors of intimate partner domestic violence.

#### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$2 million contained in this bill is a nonrecurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of FY21 shall revert to the general fund.

## **SIGNIFICANT ISSUES**

DFA noted the bill implies a contract is not yet in place between the city of Albuquerque and the nonprofit organization. Any such contract would need to contain adequate consideration for public benefit to ensure that the anti-donation clause of the New Mexico Constitution is not violated.
