SUMMARY

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Memorial 20 (SM 20) establishes a task force to make recommendations on how two bells from the historic battleship USS New Mexico, one on display at the university of New Mexico (1945) and one in the collection of the New Mexico history museum (1948), might be best displayed and identify any funding that might be necessary for the appropriate display of the bells.

The task force would include representatives from the Department of Cultural Affairs, Department of Veterans' Services, Division of Facilities Management of the General Services Department, University of New Mexico, Navy League of the United States, New Mexico Council; and others with expertise and interest in the history of the USS New Mexico.

SM20 requires the task force to present its report and recommendations to the Military and Veterans' Affairs Committee by October 2, 2020.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

SM20 does not contain an appropriation and will not impact the Department of Cultural Affairs operating budget.

However SM20 will require current staff at all agencies to increase workload until the report is due in October of 2020.
