18	A. A taxpayer who is a first responder may claim an
19	exemption from income includable in an amount not to exceed
20	twenty percent of the individual's net income received as a
21	first responder for taxable year 2020.
22	B. Prior to claiming the exemption provided by this
23	section, a taxpayer shall apply to the department on forms and
24	in a manner required by the department for certifying that the
25	taxpayer is a first responder for purposes of this section.
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	1	C. As used in this section, "first responder" means
	2	a person referred to as a first responder in any executive
	3	order issued by the governor in 2020 relating to the
	4	coronavirus disease 2019 pandemic."
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
