- 1. Page 4, Line 8: after "organization" strike the semi-colon and insert ", and the customer is by rate class:"
- 2. Page 4, between Lines 8 & 9: insert:
 - "(1) a residential retail customer, or
- (2) a small commercial retail customer, provided that small commercial retail customers shall not consume more than forty percent of the aggregate of energy produced from each community solar facility;"
- 3. Page 4, Line 10: insert at the end of the line "a qualifying utility,"
- 4. Page 6, Line 22: strike "twenty"
- 5. Page 6, line 23: after "consumption" insert "including the percentage of renewable energy provided pursuant to the renewable energy portfolio standards of the Energy Transition Act"
- 6. Page 9, Lines 19 & 21: after "require" strike from "a" on line 19 through "cap" on line 21 and insert in lieu thereof: "thirty percent of electricity produced from each community solar facility"
- 7. Page 9, Line 22: strike "In facilitation of this target,"
- 8. Page 10, Line 4: after "cap" insert ", consistent with Section 13-1-21 NMSA 1978 regarding resident business and resident veteran business preferences"
- 9. Page 10, Line 15: after "facility" insert ", such that a qualifying utility and its non-subscribing customers do not subsidize the costs attributable to the subscriber organization pursuant to this paragraph"
- 10. Page 10, Line 22: after "terms" insert ", security interests"
- 11. Page 10, Line 24: after "subscription" insert ", as well as grievance and enforcement procedures"
- 12. Page 11, Line 4: after "charges" insert ", and provided that non-subscribers do not subsidize costs attributable to subscribers"
- 13. Page 12, Lines 22 to 25 & Page 13, Lines 1 to 4: Strike Section 9.
- 14. Renumber Succeeding Sections Accordingly.
