A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
AMENDING JOINT RULE 10-1 FOR THE FIRST SESSION OF THE FIFTY-
FIFTH LEGISLATURE TO PROVIDE THAT REQUESTS TO DRAFT OR PREPARE
A BILL MUST BE MADE BY THE TWENTY-FOURTH DAY OF THE SESSION.

WHEREAS, Legislative Joint Rule 8-1 provides for the
adoption, amendment or repeal of joint rules by concurrent
resolution approved by two-thirds of the membership of each
house;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF
REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO, THE SENATE
CONCURRING THEREIN, that Joint Rule 10-1 be amended to read:

"JOINT SESSIONS (10-1)

A. The legislative council service shall
not draft or prepare a bill for introduction at any
regular session of the legislature that convenes in

1 an odd-numbered year unless the request to draft or
2 prepare the bill for introduction has been received
3 by the legislative council service prior to 5:00
4 p.m. on the twenty-eighth calendar day of that
5 session. The legislative council service shall not
6 draft or prepare a bill for introduction at any
7 regular session of the legislature that convenes in
8 an even-numbered year unless the request to draft or
9 prepare the bill for introduction has been received
10 by the legislative council service prior to 5:00
11 p.m. on the thirteenth calendar day of that session.
12 The limitation provided in this rule does not apply
13 to the general appropriation bill, bills to provide
14 for the current expenses of the government and such
15 bills as may be referred to the legislature by the
16 governor by special message specifically setting
17 forth the emergency or necessity requiring such
18 legislation.

19 B. If an interim committee has endorsed
20 a bill, resolution or memorial, the legislative
21 council service shall draft and prepare the bill,
22 resolution or memorial for introduction in only one
23 house.

24 C. The legislative council service shall
25 draft and prepare bills, resolutions and memorials

1 requested by the governor or the various
2 departments, institutions and agencies of the state
3 for introduction in only one house.

4 D. For the first session of the fifty-
5 fifth legislature, the legislative council service
6 shall not draft or prepare a bill for introduction
7 unless the request to draft or prepare the bill for
8 introduction has been received by the legislative
9 council service prior to 3:00 p.m. on the twenty-
10 fourth calendar day of that session. The limitation
11 provided in this rule does not apply to the general
12 appropriation bill, bills to provide for the current
13 expenses of the government and such bills as may be
14 referred to the legislature by the governor by
15 special message specifically setting forth the
16 emergency or necessity requiring such legislation.".
