BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

This bill amends the Public Works Apprentice and Training Act to include street, highway, bridge, road, utility, and maintenance contract projects within the public works construction projects that are subject to employer contributions to approved apprentice and training programs in New Mexico and requires employer participation in the Public Works Apprentice and Training Fund administered by the Workforce Solutions Department.
