BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis: This bill amends Section 26-2C-25 NMSA 1978 of the Cannabis Regulation Act, “Personal Use of Cannabis”. Amended language clarifies activities related to cannabis possession, use, display, purchase, and transport for individuals in the state of New Mexico, specifically that cannabis odor, nor cannabis possession shall not constitute grounds for a law enforcement officer to stop, detain or search a person/property absent reasonable suspicion of criminal activity.
