BILL SUMMARY

<u>Synopsis:</u> Increases the penalty for a felon and a serious violent felon found in possession of a firearm. Provides that a person convicted of possession of a firearm or destructive device is not eligible for earned meritorious deductions.

Makes it a second-degree felony for a felon found in possession of a firearm (up from a thirddegree felony) and shall be sentenced to a minimum term of nine years imprisonment. A person convicted under this section (30-7-16) is not eligible for earned meritorious deductions provided under Sec. 33-2-34.
