BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis: HB 284 will require employees of the Children, Youth and Families Department to only use department issued electronic devices for communications related to their duties. Failure to use department issued electronic devices for work related duties may constitute grounds for immediate termination of employment. This requirement shall be implemented by January 1, 2025.

All electronic records shall be retained for a period of at least twenty-four years after the end of an employee's employment.
