BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis: This bill is directed toward for-profit entities (3.I.) with websites that allow children under the age of 18 to access their sites, and collect the personal data of those children in order to sell. The Judiciary does not gather personally identifying information from children under the age of 18, and does not rent, sell, or distribute the personally identifying information captured in court documents.

The Judiciary does not target or allow online access to children under the age of 18 to Secured Odyssey Public Access, re:SearchNM, or File & Serve. These three web applications are used by registered attorneys, self-represented litigants, and judiciary justice partners in the execution of legal cases.
